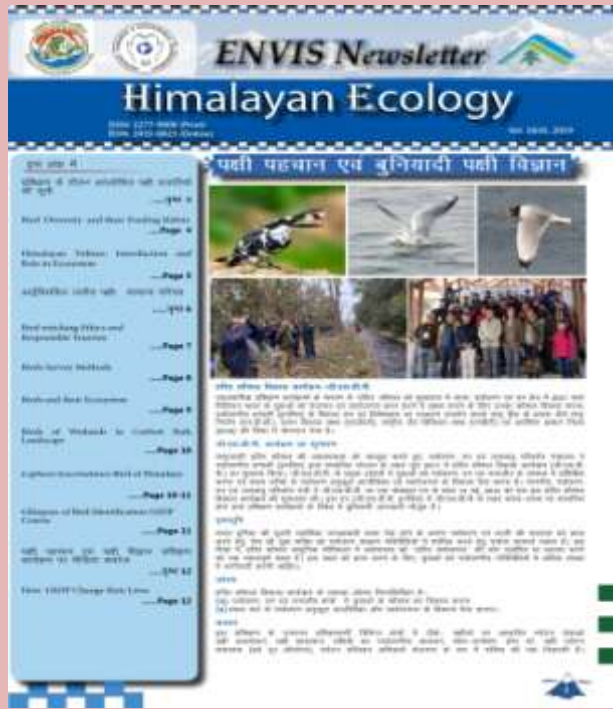




**Call for Articles under ENVIS

It is anticipated that they will be published in 2022-2023 issue of ENVIS Newsletter.

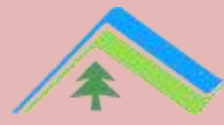
